In preparation to receive Holy Communion at the Liturgy of Presanctified Gifts, please remember that you should not eat or drink after 12:00 noon. For those who are ill, pregnant, or nursing, please contact Fr. Daniel. Those who had confession on the prior Sunday do not need to have confession again to receive Holy Communion at the Liturgy of Presanctified Gifts unless a serious sin has been committed.

In preparation for the Sacrament of Holy Unction, parishioners should have confession beforehand, either before the service begins or at least the prior Sunday.
