Those who had confession on the prior Sunday do not need to have confession again to receive Holy Communion at the Liturgy of Presanctified Gifts unless a serious sin has been committed.

In preparation for the Sacrament of Holy Unction, parishioners should have confession beforehand, either before the service begins or at least the prior Sunday.
