RaiseRight Fundraiser

Gift card orders through the RaiseRight fundraiser program will be taken through Sunday, May 7, 2023, during coffee hour. Gift cards will be distributed on Sunday, May 14, 2023. The full list of current retailers and rebates is available here. Cash or checks only, please.

This is how the program works: Our parish purchases gift cards at a discount, sells them

at face value, and then keeps the difference. For example, our parish purchases a \$100 grocery store gift card at a discount for \$95, a parishioner purchases the gift card for \$100, and our parish keeps the \$5 difference. The gift cards can be purchased for gifts or everyday purchases such as groceries, gas, and restaurants.

Egg Hunt and Luncheon

The children's egg hunt will be held after Liturgy on Sunday, April 23 (St. Thomas Sunday) in the church yard (weather permitting). A luncheon will also be held. Pizza will be provided. *If you are able to help, please bring a side dish or dessert for the luncheon.*
