Update: Building Fund

The masonry restoration work is scheduled to begin in late October. It is expected to take about two weeks and should not interfere with any church services. The work includes repointing the whole front wall, repointing the cupola, repointing 11 foot sections on each side extending from the front, repointing the chimney, applying water repellent to the repointed areas, repairing two windowsills, and repairing the steps. The total cost will be about \$29,000-\$30,000. A down payment of \$7,000 was made to schedule the job. The building fund currently has a total of about \$22,000 after making the down payment. The balance of \$22,000-\$23,000 will need to be paid after the job is complete.
