## Update: Building Project

God willing, the masonry restoration work at our church is scheduled to begin on Monday, November 4, 2024. It is expected to take about two weeks and should not interfere with any scheduled Divine services. If anyone needs to come to the church during the daytime Monday through Friday while the work is being done, please use the backdoor entrance. We will keep the back gates unlocked during this time. Also, during the construction work, children should be supervised in the church yard, since there will be a boom lift and other contractor items.

The work includes repointing the whole front wall, repointing the cupola, repointing 11 foot sections on each side extending from the front, repointing the chimney, applying water repellent to the repointed areas, repairing two windowsills, and repairing the steps. The total cost will be about \$29,000-\$30,000. A down payment of \$7,000 was made to schedule the job. The building fund currently has a total of about \$25,000 after making the down payment. The balance of \$22,000-\$23,000 will be paid after the job is complete. *Thank you to everyone who contributed toward this project!*

After the masonry restoration work is complete, the plaster on the walls in the choir loft area will need to be repaired.
