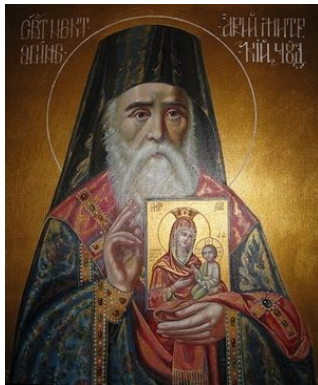
## Young Adult Talk with Fr. Daniel
